

NAPIER AWARDS FOR CREATIVE LEADERSHIP RECOMMENDATION INSTRUCTIONS

Through the Napier Awards, the Pilgrim Place community seeks to nurture leadership committed to long-term efforts for a just, peaceful, and sustainable world. In the 2021-2022 academic year we have invited proposals for two \$20,000 Napier Awards for Creative Leadership. Awards will be made to seniors at the undergraduate Claremont Colleges in 2021-22 who demonstrate leadership promise in fostering justice for all people, caring for the earth, or nurturing peace and reconciliation. With these Awards we are especially eager to stimulate the integration of theory and practice among future leaders. Successful applicants must have demonstrated the personal skills for effective leadership, must show a broad knowledge of the background and current issues of the particular field they wish to address, and must present a creative proposal for a practical project in which they will be engaged during at least part of their first year following graduation. Please write a letter of recommendation answering the following questions:

1. What have you observed about the applicant's leadership skills?
2. How has the applicant demonstrated a solid knowledge of the field chosen?
3. How has the applicant modeled the better future which he/she seeks?
4. Is there more that leads you to believe the applicant is worthy to receive a Napier Awards?
5. What is your evaluation of the project proposal?
6. If you are related to the site where the student proposes to carry out the project, would you welcome this student and this project? Is it suitable for your organization's mission?
